Cleaning and disinfecting of tables further to this will be done as required throughout the day in response to circumstances as they arise. ✓ Frequently touched surfaces will be kept visibly clean and cleaned at least twice per day or more frequently if required in response to circumstances as they arise during the course of the day. ✓ Additional cleaners available throughout the day and external contract cleaners/community employment scheme to do a thorough clean of all areas at the end of each day. ✓ Arrangements have been put in place for the regular and safe emptying of bins and the use of pedal bins to avoid hand contact. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Additional supplies of cleaning materials and disinfectants for the enhanced cleaning regime are available to each class grouping. ➤ Supplies of cleaning materials and disinfectants have been secured and will be regularly checked and maintained throughout the school.
